18th Lions International Youth Exchange Scholarship Theme of Essay Competition: Smart City and the Environment **Invitation to Final Competition and Award Ceremony**

The following are the details of the finalists presentation and award ceremony of the essay competition.

Date: Saturday, 10th March, 2017.

Level 2, the Atrium at Sunshine City Plaza Phase IV, On Shing Street, Venue:

Time and Flow:

You should arrive at the venue at 10:00am for registration. Between10:30am and 12:30pm there will be the determination of the candidates' sequence of presentation by random drawing. Candidates will be briefed on the rules and scoring scheme of the competition and will be given time for rehearsal.

The ceremony officially begins at 2:00pm but you are requested to report to the venue at least 30 minutes before the start of the ceremony. If you miss the registration in the morning you can still register before 1:30pm but there will not be the briefing nor the rehearsal.

The ceremony is expected to end at 5:00pm. The competition results will be announced and certificates will be awarded towards the end of the ceremony.

Presentation:

There will be 12 candidates from Hong Kong and 5 from Chinese Mainland, making a total of 17 presentations. Each candidate will be allotted a 5-minute time slot. Out of these 5 minutes, a maximum length of 4 minutes will be allowed for your presentation. The presentation should be done in English with the aid of PowerPoint slides and on the Essay that you had originally submitted to the competition which is of the theme 'Smart City and the Environment'. The front page of your PowerPoint should be the introduction of yourself. Please save your PowerPoint slides in a USB device and bring it to the venue for uploading to the computer at registration.

Please note that the score will solely be based on your performance in the presentation and no reference will be made to your previous scores in the essay writing and in the first round interview.
